World Religions - Atheism

Atheism - belief that there is no God

- -we don't usually think of this as a religion but everyone is worshiping something
- -self and intellect are worshiped (you get to be the ultimate authority)
- -this really appeals to our sin nature (teens want freedom)
- *this doesn't mean that all atheists are immoral

Atheist vs Agnostic

- -agnostics belief that there is a God we just can't know anything about him
- -in a practical sense a large number of Americans are agnostic

Romans 1:20

- -The creation of the world shows there is a powerful creator
- -We can learn a lot about the existence and nature of God from creation (Proverbs 6:6-8)
- *the more I studied science the more I was in awe of God
- "Atheism is so senseless. When I look at the solar system. I see the earth at the right distance from the sun to receive the proper amounts of heat and light. This did not happen by chance" -Isaac Newton

Psalm 19:1-2

- -Everything in creation cries out that there is a great creator
- *going to the ballfield at night
- **what is something in nature that makes you think God is awesome?
- *Creation is the first thing I would point to if I wanted to talk to an atheist about God
- -If God is so evident in creation then why are their atheists?

Romans 1:21-23

- -our sin nature can darken us to the reality of God
- *pride or pain causes a person to want to be God
- -The Bible explains life like no other book
- -God's word humbles us
- -God's word also encourages us that we don't have to do it on our own
- *the palm Sunday donkey
- **What's a time the Bible has proved valuable in your life
- *God's world and God's word both testify that he is real and that he is valuable
